## **Please note:**

- Five scholarships will be awarded at 50% of tuition and five will be awarded at 20% of tuition.
  - > Book and tools are not included in these scholarships.
  - Scholarship Award will be based on the program that the application selects.
  - Applicants must provide all of the items under the application criteria on or prior to the deadline.
  - > The award is given upon completion of the program.
  - To be eligible for any program offered at WTC, a prospective student must receive a high school diploma from these high schools prior to enrollment.



## **Application Criteria:**

- Submit a minimum of three (3) letters of recommendation: a) from student's current or former teacher, b) campus of current enrollment counselor or other administrator, c) select one: current employer, supervisor of community service activities, or coach/sponsor of extra-curricular activities.
- Submit a (300+) word essay detailing "Why you are pursuing a career in \_\_\_\_\_\_". Essay should include, but is not limited to, grades, school activities, work experience, previous training, and goals.
- Submit a copy of your current high school transcript (and diploma upon applicability) with a high school administrator's signature. A 2.3 (78%) GPA or higher is required.
- Minimum of 20 community service hours, signed by sponsors (community group, school, etc.)
